Ranaji Deb's thesis focuses on the problem of representation of suicide across different media, periods and cultures. The study outlines the history of the motive of suicide in visual arts with frequent allusions to mythology and literature, discusses main sociological and psychological works on the subject, and concludes with an empirical study of suicide imagery online.

The thesis is highly ambitious in its scope and goals, the author has meticulously researched both the visual material and scholarly literature and managed to move beyond mere compilation and description and venture into a demanding data analysis of the visual representation of suicide in contemporary internet culture. Unfortunately, the final section (pp. 39-71) remains somewhat open-ended: instead of a conclusion, which would summarize, critically assess and evaluate his findings, the author proposes further extensions of his research. A more detailed explanation and

ustification of the study is missing – however, I still appreciate the courage to take or
such an immense task and the enormous effort that was needed for it. I recommend
the thesis for defence and suggest A as the final grade.
