The student in advance split the thesis to several parts. She started with provision of basic methods of the whole work. The method is the professional explanation and definition of the concept of narcissism, from history, through psychology research of the definition in history and to present understanding of narcissism in the era of digitalism, which Xavier Dolan is a part of, as well. The thesis work assumes, that the whole work, or almost every film of Xavier Dolan is, partly, self-centered and it is logically joint with the narcissism. Is it a speech of too young author with promising of improving his style into the future, or is Xavier Dolan a author with the concrete, invariable style and many viewers could never understand his specific point of view of our complicated world and non-specific definition of art? The student continues with connection of narcissism and art (and of course cinema) and then fluently continues with the portrait of Xavier Dolan as a persona, director and actor in his very personal movies consist of, as we assume, narcissism. The student splits his portfolio into two parts; movies only directed by Dolan, and movies directed by Dolan and starring himself in them, and what difference it makes in the question of narcissism. The aim of the thesis is to understand why his movies are dubbed and whether and how the elements that lead to this alleged narcissism have also affected his universality and popularity, as the student writes in the text. And to explain why exactly Dolan is the perfect example for this kind of thesis. The question that now comes to mind is whether celebrities become narcissistic after achieving fame or whether their narcissism is one of the reasons why they achieve fame. As one of the defining traits of narcissists is their belief that they belong to a group of special people and that they are destined for greater things, student writes. Art, it seems, turns towards narcissism and, in a way, embraces narcissistic tendencies and shines a light on them rather than shying away from them, student continues toward to the „main star“ of her thesis. By the similar quotes student foreshadows parallels between general research and concrete analysis of work, in the second part of the thesis, of Xavier Dolan; the work we could call the self-portrait: a portrait of the artist done by the artist. It is another chapter done by student, which is

directly connected with the main part of the thesis, but it could stand alone as an interesting historic and scientific article in itself, based on some well chosen sources. But finally in the chapter Self-portraits in cinema: Actors/Auteurs student fluently joins the whole detailed first methodological part of the thesis with the work of Xavier Dolan and then continues, for the rest of the work, on focusing on his career, films and self-portraits. Reader could realize due to the text, that Dolan is, in a way of narcissism, some kind of follower of such famous names, as Orson Welles, Woody Allen, Spike Lee or M. Night Shyamalan. But as we read later, Dolan's movies are some kind of semi-portraits, based on his gay orientation and complicated relationship with mother (film *I Killed My Mother* says everything in the title...). They have something in common especially with the work of Allen, than with the other mentioned artists. Splitting of the next chapters into characterizing Dolan's work through his personality (personality, his point of view about criticism, actor, director...) and by this method analyzing films is way better way than to split the main part of the thesis into the chapters only dedicated to concrete films. This is the major problem in theses, or any annual works at the FTF VŠMU and to read more clever structured works (as in this case) is much more interesting and better approaching the goals. The clever decision was, as well, using some footages from movies and on the close-ups, and another types of shots, finding the marks of narcissism, but not just them, in Dolan's work. Analyzing through shots, cinematography and finding metaphors, motifs and proximity with protagonists led the student to the right answers to the questions laid at the beginning. The thesis is elaborated with accuracy, passion for the theme, focus on the right aspects of theme of narcissism in the work of Xavier Dolan. It is easy to read and for enthusiastic readers; lovers of cinema, is the thesis perfect example of combination of science text and comprehensible, clear, but not trivial kind of text. It is a result of using the right sources, vast bibliography and student's own ideas. I recommend the thesis to be accepted and to evaluate with the mark A.
